

Redemptive gifts and the Tabernacle



Redemptive Gifts is really a study about YHVH; what He is like and how you and I all of creation reflect His nature.

Romans 1:19-20 "...because what may be known of God is manifest in them, for God has shown it to them. For since the creation of the world, His invisible attributes are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse."

- All of creation is representative of who He is
- He is good, everything He made is good, no "good or bad" gifts

Romans 12: 4-8 4 "For just as in one [physical] body we have many parts, and these parts do not all have the same function or special use, 5 so we, who are many, are [nevertheless just] one body in Christ, and individually [we are] parts one of another [mutually dependent on each other]. 6 Since we have gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, each of us is to use them accordingly: if [someone has the gift of] prophecy, [let him speak a new message from God to His people] in proportion to the faith possessed; 7 if service, in the act of serving; or he who teaches, in the act of teaching; 8 or he who encourages, in the act of encouragement; he who gives, with generosity; he who leads, [a]with diligence; he who shows mercy [in caring for others], with cheerfulness"

- He was intentional in the distribution of the gifts, and He takes pleasure in the diversity of gifts

The gifts validate identity - *John 8:32 "And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free."*

- Identity gifts vs. manifestation gifts
- Brings freedom, not restriction
- Releases you to be who you were created to be, with joy
- Allows you to release others to be who they were created to be, and enjoy them

- Provides a more accurate picture of the person of YHVH, so you can enjoy Him
- Confronts idolatrous images of YHVH in our own hearts

The gifts illustrate capacity, attribute no righteousness - *Romans 12:1-4 "I beseech you therefore brethren, by the mercies of God that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is the good, acceptable and perfect will of YHVH. For I say, through the grace given to me, to everyone who is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think soberly, as God has dealt to each one a measure of faith. For as we have many members in one body, but all the members do not have the same function."*

- These gifts show our capacity, not what we have already attained
- Because of our sin nature the gifts can be perverted
- Hitler, Stalin had Redemptive Gifts
- All capacity must be developed, matured, refined, realized
- Positional authority vs. Earned authority
- Supernatural Reflection: Recognizing and Understanding Redemptive Gifts

YHVH's highest goal is to make you like His son - *Romans 8:29 "For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren".*

- No one is exempt from becoming Christ-like or developing fruit of the Spirit
- Positions us to complete the most important assignment in this life

Mark 12:30-31 "And you shall love the Lord your God with all your soul and with all your mind, and with all your strength. This is the first commandment".


I Corinthians 13:1-2 "Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I have become sounding brass or a clanging cymbal. And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing".

Becoming lumberjacks - *Matthew 7:3-5 "And why do you look at the speck in your brother's eye, but do not consider the plank in your own eye? Or how can you say to your brother, 'Let me remove the speck from your eye'; and look, a plank is in your eye?"*

- Focus on your own beams of timber, not other's tiny particles
- The "particle focus" mindset also leads to comparisons, which the Word warns us against
- You can't assume that every Redemptive Gift thinks and feels the same way that you do about things
- People's gifts display variations depending on birth order, woundedness, and how they were parented
- There are also high-test, mid-grade, and unleaded variations. In some cases, I have observed super-test fuel (like they use in the Indy cars) - Arthur Burk calls this amplification

Goal of this teaching is to inspire you to possess your birthright - Ephesians 4:15 “but speaking the truth in love, may grow up in all things unto Him who is the head” – Christ

- Earn authority, complete the course – so your kids can do the same, restoring and releasing generational blessings to your family line
- In order to do this you MUST have a love affair with truth/the Truth
- If you want to be a champion you hire a trainer not to be sweet to you but to make you the best you can be



Prophet = Altar of Burnt offerings. Prophet stands for righteousness

Exodus 27:1



Prophet symbolizes dealing with sin.

A place where you have to acknowledge your sin, deal with it and receive forgiveness.


1. First offering will be a burnt offering to sanctify the altar and for the Lord to come.
2. Second offering is a meal offering, fruit and grain. (Symbolizes man's labor as an offer to YHVH. Women could offer cookies, wheat, bread, etc. Oil, salt and fragrances was added by the priest)
3. Third offering a peace offering – Offer for reconciliation
4. Fourth offer a sin offering – (only once a year on the Day of Atonement)
5. Fifth offering a trespassing offer – Sin against man, holy things or to consecrate, sanctify or bless.

Yeshua's blood symbolizes all 5 offerings today.

Prophet has a very high standard of holiness for himself and other. Prophet knows that repentance is the first step to know the heart of the Lord. Prophet will rather walk with fear of the Lord than fear of man. Only if Prophet walks in the high standard of holiness, can he bring others to walk in it as well. Prophet's birthright is to bring people out of bondage through repentance, because repentance brings forgiveness.

Servant = Bronze laver used for cleansing; facilitates transition into throne room

Exodus 30:18



The laver supplied water for the offerings. The priests also used the water to clean and sanctify themselves before the offer. After the offer, the priest had to cleanse himself from the blood before he could come into the presence of the Lord.

Servant was placed strategically between prophet and teacher. Servant is the middleman to come into the presence of the Lord.

Joshua and his men had to wait 7 days outside the city gate after war before they could enter the city again. They had to wash themselves a certain amount of times. They also had to wash and cleanse whatever they brought back as spoils of war.

It was also an emotional cleansing of going back from a soldier to a dad. As a spiritual cleansing, they had to go from a place of war to a place of intimacy with God.


Servant helps to serve whoever is in a position of leadership. To help them transition from a place of power to a place of submission under the authority of the Lord, and to then go into intimacy with Him.

Servant cleanses everything that is ugly and dirty in order for us to go into the Holy of Holies, clean.

Servant helps to cleanse spiritually so that we can end our day in intimacy at the feet of our King, and not in war.

Teacher = Table of Showbread; Yeshua is the True Bread of Life, Word Incarnate

Exodus 25:23



Represents Communion

On the table there is 6 breads, then the wine in the middle, then 6 breads again.
The number 12 represents the government of YHVH on earth.

The bread is before the incense, representing that the Word comes before worship.
The bread symbolizes the Word, Yeshua, and the King.

Teacher's birthright is to bring down the government of YHVH, and to teach the rest how to walk in it.
Teacher must search for the government of YHVH in the Word, and then bring it to the body of Christ.

Teacher reads the Word, receives revelation, and out of the revelation comes forth worship, which takes teacher into a new dimension to pull down the government of YHVH to earth. Teacher must have discipline to daily spend time in the Word for new revelation.

Teacher must go to the Word to receive new things about the Glory of YHVH, new things about the nature of YHVH and the character of Yeshua, new revelation about His kingdom, and then react with worship.

Worship is the expression of what the Word says and is, through revelation.

Then the government of YHVH realizes from the spirit into reality.

Exhorter – Lampstand. Candlestick sheds light. Oil needed to be pure.

Exodus 25:31



Exhorter gets placed between Teacher (Word) and Giver (Incense), to give them light.

Exhorter brings light to the revelation of Yeshua which Teacher sees in the Word, and then brings light to the Worship anointing that Giver has. The worship anointing Giver has is to worship YHVH from the Word.

Exhorter's light is the revelation of Yeshua, who He is and what He does. Exhorter brings the revelation from the Father's heart.

Exhorter can only bring light if there is oil. Light flows from the oil.

The oil is pure and clean. It took 7 days to prepare and sanctify the oil for the lamp. The oil could only be used for one day, representing that new revelation has to be brought daily. This is the challenge for exhorter.

Exhorter looks for reaction from people to confirm themselves. The reaction can cause damage and can cause exhorter to speak from soul instead of spirit. If exhorter mixes soul with spirit, other people's spirits can be damaged through exhorter's own gain agenda.

When Exhorter speaks and walks in purity in the spirit, then there is an anointing from the Throne Room that flows through Exhorter to others. When the Truth of the Lord gets revealed, others receive it directly to their spirits and their souls wait on the sideline.

No other gift has the authority to bring in Light like Exhorter. Exhorter's birthright stretches from day 4 from the sun and the moon, to the tabernacle with the lampstand, to bring forth light. Both have to do with light.

The Lord expects that light to be pure and sanctified. The light must come from the spirit and not the soul. The oil, which represents the words, must be pure and clean. The oil of Holy Spirit must flow to the spirit of Exhorter, in order for it to flow to others.

Exhorter reveals YHVH in a world that does not know Him yet. But when exhorter is taking the glory away from YHVH and giving it to themselves, they will burn out like a star that is busy dying.

Giver = Altar of Incense - worship and intercession flowing from relationship. Inspires gratitude

Exodus 30:1



The altar of Incense brings intercession and worship together in one action. *Psalms 141:2 "Let my prayer be counted as incense before You; The lifting up of my hands as the evening offering."*

Giver is in the middle of Prophet and Mercy.

Prophet has a high calling for warfare and intercession, to separate heaven and earth. Mercy has a high calling for worship. Giver brings the two together.

It is intercession that flows from a grateful heart from past experiences.

Through the degree that Giver is familiar with the Works of YHVH to the degree that Giver can recognize and give honor for what the Lord has done, authority through intercession will begin to manifest.

Israel has the redemptive gift of Giver as a nation. That is why the Lord constantly told them to remember the past and the good the Lord had done for them before.

The fire used for the altar of incense came from the altar of burnt offerings. Incense were not allowed to be burned before a blood offering was given. There cannot be a thanksgiving offer, before an offer of repentance.

Prophet lays the foundation for thanksgiving and holiness and purity, and giver builds on that foundation through intercession.

Giver gives life to prayers and worship.

When Giver brings intercession and worship together, there is an anointing to fight in the heavens through intercession and to receive victory through worship.

Cain left behind generational curses.

Abraham left behind generational blessings:

Abraham died at 175 – 175 years of blessings carried over to Isaac.

- Isaac died at 180 – 355 years of blessings carried over to Jacob who became the whole Israel.

Matthew was very rich. He left all his money and for generations after him that was not his own, he left gifts by writing the very first book in the New Testament.

Matthew was a tax's collector. In the Roman days tax's collectors was very rich. The government would auction of cities tax's for the next 10 years. Let's say the city will owe the government \$100 over the next 10 years. The government will auction the cities tax of to the highest bidder. The government will collect the money from the highest bidder. Then for the next 10 years it is that parson's responsibility to collect taxes for himself. He may even collect more than he paid. How he collect the money has nothing to do with the government any more. Tax's collectors was not popular people and was very rich, money was very imported to them and it was a family business. When Matthew gave it all up to follow Yeshua he did it not very likely, it was a big deal. Are you willing to give it all up for the One who has set you free and gives you live?

Ruler = Arc of the Covenant. True leadership is submitted to YHVH's law.

Exodus 25:10



The ark was made of solid wood and covered in gold. Only four holy men could carry the ark. It weighed over 1,500 pounds. It was made planks, not plywood, so it was very heavy. At 5 feet long and 3 feet high and 3 feet wide, it held the stone tablets, a jar of manna and Aaron's rod. The ark was covered with gold leaf (and not the fine gold leaf that we know today) and had a solid golden lid, solid golden cherubim on the lid and when they traveled the ark had a covering. The ark would have been too heavy for only 4 men to carry it and that is why it is said that the Lord carried the ark Himself.

The ark contains 3 holy things

1. The stones with the commandments written on them.
2. Golden pot full of manna.
3. The staff of Aaron that bloomed.

The above mentioned, 3 things is the basis of Rulers authority.

1. Ruler must submit under the commandments of the Lord in order to be placed over something else.
2. The manna is a symbol of life giving. Life flows from Ruler to others.
3. The symbol that YHVH has placed Ruler in the position they are in.

The first two were alone in the ark for years. Only when Aaron died did his staff bloom, and it was placed in the ark.

It was only after rebellion came into the camp that the Lord gave the Levites the task as Priests. The Lord allowed Moses to lead the Israelites with only the first two items as authority for years.

Ruler was created to life in the Commandments of the Lord, through the Word, and through that have authority over others. Ruler is the one who lets others grow in and through the Word.

Ruler must first master the first two before receiving the Staff as a symbol of YHVH choosing him to lead.

Mercy = Mercy Seat. Mercy Seat representing where the glory of The Lord resides.

Exodus 25:17



The Mercy seat is placed over the Arc of the Covenant. It is where the 2 cherubim's meet.

It is there where the Glory of YHVH manifested physically, just above the two angels of the golden angels.

It was the Presence of YHVH in a container that did not swallow up the rest of the unholy world around it.

Mercy is the holder for the Presence of YHVH and to take it to the rest of the world, just on a spiritual level.

Every person's spirit has the authority to walk over the threshold from earth to heaven into the spirit.

Mercy has to soak up the presence of YHVH and then bring it to the rest of the spirit, and to not keep it for themselves.

Mercy can stay in the presence of the Lord the whole day, no matter what they are busy doing.

Mercy is the bridge between heaven and earth.

Mercy has a "Blessing of presence" anointing.

Without saying a word, Mercy will change the spiritual atmosphere.
